

The Old School, Clayhanger, Devon



This stone built former school set in the small village of Clayhanger in Devon was converted in the late 1950's into a two bedroom cottage. Although cosy and compact, the cottage had no first floor bathroom.

By demolishing much of the former porch (now a larder) and lowering the floor level it was possible to add a room in the roof accessible from the stair landing. Careful selection of materials, attention to detail and a high standard of construction makes the extension blend almost seamlessly with the existing house.

A new central heating boiler completed the improvements.
